## GRADE 12

### CRETIN-DERHAM HALL REGISTRATION GUIDE

Course offerings are listed by department in the Curriculum Guide. Every attempt is made to schedule students into their first choice. However, everyone may not receive the electives they request. Each student must choose alternate classes during registration in the event of a scheduling conflict, or if classes are full or not offered.

**Students will register for the following:**

#### **ENGLISH AND RELIGION REQUIREMENTS:**

**Choose one yearlong sequence from the following:**

- Philosophy/Theology/Social Justice-Honors **and** Introduction to College Literature-Honors **or**
- Senior Seminar-Religion **and** English 12 **or**
- Senior Seminar-Religion **and** English 12 – Writing Studio CIS **or**
- Senior Seminar-Religion **and** Introduction to College Literature-Honors **or**
- SrIntSymposium (Spectrum)-Honors

#### **SOCIAL STUDIES REQUIREMENT WITHIN GRADES 11 AND 12:**

**Required: Four social studies classes within grades 11 and 12 to include:**

- Economics (Grade 11 or 12) **and**
- AP US Government (two trimesters in Grade 11 or 12) **and**
- 1 Social Studies elective (Grade 11 or 12)  
**OR**
- Economics (Grade 11 or 12) **and**
- US Government (Grade 12) **and**
- 2 Social Studies electives (Grade 11 or 12)  
**OR**
- AP Micro Economics (two trimesters in Grade 11 or 12) **and**
- AP US Government (two trimesters in Grade 11 or 12)  
**OR**
- AP Micro Economics (two trimesters in Grade 11 or 12) **and**
- US Government (Grade 12) **and**
- 1 Social Studies elective (Grade 11 or 12)

**Note:** Senior Interdisciplinary Symposium-honors (Spectrum) fulfills **2 required Social Studies credits**

#### **ELECTIVES**

Required: elective courses to fill 7 class hours each trimester.

Students who choose to continue in their Math, Science and World Language sequences should register for the courses recommended by their current teacher.

#### **ALTERNATE CLASSES**

Required: Students must register for 2 alternate classes each trimester.
