

## Instructions to download public library books using iPad APP Overdrive

There are multiple steps to download an eBook from the public library to your iPad. Have your library card available, as you will have to input its number. Each library has a maximum number of eBooks that you may have out at one time. They can be used for 21 days, and they are automatically deleted from your Overdrive APP on the 21<sup>st</sup> day.

1. Open the APP in your *Book Readers* folder called *Overdrive*.
2. Click on the Get Books+ icon in the top right corner.
3. Click on the Add a Library + .
4. Type in St. Paul Public Library in the search line and press select.
5. Once the St. Paul Public Library Digital Catalog opens in a new page, you may select *Browse* to view different genres of books, or click *Search* to look for a particular title.
6. Once the page of individual books loads, you may search within those results, or you may scroll through the search results. Note that it indicates whether the book is available electronically or not.
7. You may click on an individual book's link to read more about the book.
8. The St. Paul Public Library allows for digital downloads in Kindle Book format, or Adobe EPub eBook format. Since your iPad does not have the Kindle APP loaded on it, select the Adobe ePub *Add to Book Cart* tab.
9. On the next screen, select *Proceed to Checkout*.
10. You will then be required to type in your library card number (from the back of the card) on the log in screen.
11. The next screen will ask you to confirm your request. If the correct book is listed, click on the *Confirm Checkout*.
12. Press the *Download* tab and the book will be added to your Overdrive APP for you to read.
