Our 14-day / 13-night trip takes place from June 13 - 27, 2023 and will be led by CDH Spanish instructor and LaSallian Global Studies Program Coordinator, Rebecca Medellin (CDH 1988) and Alexis Howe, Spanish instructor. Our tour will include overnight stays in Madrid, Valladolid, Zaragoza, and Barcelona with excursions to Segovia, Urueña, Salamanca, and Pamplona. (Additional tour information on next page.) Participants must have successfully completed (B or higher) Spanish level 3 Honors to participate in this program. Participants will earn 1 Honors Global Studies credit for successfully completing the coursework which will include a final presentation which will take place after the conclusion of the trip.

The LaSallian Global Studies Program offers you the opportunity to experience the sophisticated life of a country more diverse than you could imagine. Rich in history, Spain's art, architecture, and culture will amaze you. The birthplace of some of the world's most influential artists, including Pablo Picasso, Francisco de Goya and Diego Velázquez, travel to Spain to experience the true beauty and history behind some of the most treasured art in the world. From the ancient Roman ruins, to the flamenco dancers, tapas and matadors, to the gothic cathedrals overlooking the narrow streets, and even to its captivating mountain ranges, Spain captures the true essence of a traveler's journey overseas. With a history dating all the way back to the Middle Ages and even to the Roman Empire, Spain's historic sites will transport you to another time. Our program spans four cities: Madrid, Valladolid, Zaragoza, and Barcelona. While in Madrid, see one of the most famous art pieces in the world, Pablo Picasso's La Guernica, which depicts the horrors of the Spanish Civil War, tour the royal palace and stroll in the surrounding gardens and parks. In Valladolid, we will visit the home of Miguel de Cervantes-the author of the iconic Spanish novel Don Quixote de la Mancha. Valladolid is linked to some of the most important figures in Spanish history. King Ferdinand and Queen Isabella were married here and Christopher Columbus died here. While in Zaragoza, we will stroll along the Ebro river, tour the breathtaking Plaza and Cathedral Del Pilar and the Cathedral del Salvador while admiring the Mudéjar style of architecture that can be found in many places in the city. Finally, in Barcelona, you can travel back to the medieval period and visit the towering cathedral, La Sagrada Familia. 137 years later and still unfinished, this beautiful cathedral is Spanish history you must experience. Explore the country and find yourself. It's just waiting for you to have the experience of a lifetime.
