

Cretin-Derham Hall Driver Education 2019-2020

Dear Parent or Guardian:

We are pleased to offer a complete Driver Education program for your student. The classroom instructions (30 hours) will take place at Cretin-Derham High School. The class is scheduled for 3 hours beginning immediately after school each afternoon. Any missed classes can be made up during the next session. When students earn their permit, they need to call their assigned behind the wheel (BTW) instructor. The classroom teacher will share their instructor's name and phone number on the last day of class. The behind the wheel instructor and you and/or your student will arrange 6 hours of lessons. Occasionally, another student may be in the vehicle during your student's BTW lessons.

**Classroom Instruction (30 hours) / Behind the Wheel Driving Instruction (6 hours)
Complete Program = 36 Hours**

- A payment in full of **\$399** is due at the first class.

- **Option 2**

- **\$200** paid at first class plus **\$199** paid before the last classroom session. Please contact Mr. Manor for a prorated refund if a student is unable to complete either the classroom or the BTW lessons.

Additional Notes:

- The cost of just the classroom sessions is **\$150**. Students who choose this option will receive a letter stating that they have completed 30 hours of classroom instruction not a certificate of enrollment.
- The cost of just the BTW lessons is **\$330**.
- A one time surcharge of **\$20** will be paid by students taking BTW training. A check made out to the instructor or cash is due at the first BTW lesson.
- A **\$40** fee is charged if a student "no shows" for a BTW-lesson. If a student does not complete the BTW lessons within 12 months following the classroom session, there will be an additional fee to equal the current rate for BTW instruction.

Dear Parent of New Teen Driver

New Requirements in the Graduated Driver Licensing Law

- Starting January 1, 2015, there are new requirements to get a provisional license if the teen is under 18. Teens must provide a supervised driving log when taking their driving test that's signed by a parent. The log must verify they drove under the supervision of an adult licensed driver for a minimum of 50 hours, of which 15 hours were at night.
- The practice requirement drops to 40 hours, of which 15 hours were at night, if parents attend a parent awareness class and submit their certificate of completion for the parent class at their teens' road test.
- We encourage parents to practice with their kids well beyond the new minimum requirements of the law to ensure they're prepared to drive in the many driving and weather conditions they will eventually experience on their own.
