Learning Express Instructions

What is Learning Express?

Preparing for the AP Exams

Step 1: Go to Learning Express on the LLC Webpage under Digital Resources (at the bottom of the center column).

Step 2: After clicking on the link you will come to the homepage of Learning Express. **YOU MUST REGISTER IN SCHOOL** before you start using the tools in this database, including the AP practice tests. At the top of the screen in the right hand corner, click register if you are a new user. First, make sure the drop down menu for “your institution” says Cretin Derham Hall. We recommend you use your CDH email address as your username. Once all fields are completed, click “Create Account”.

Step 3: Return to the Home page of Learning Express, and select/scroll to the College Preparation Center box. Choose “Prepare for Your AP Exam”.

Step 4: Choose the AP test you want to practice. There are usually two different tests to take for each AP course. Click on “launch” to get started. Note that you have three options in the way you take the AP exam: simulation (timed), practice (see the answers later), or learner (see the answers immediately). You may want try starting with the learner format, before trying the other tests. On the iPad, these selections are at the bottom of the directions page.

Step 5: If you are at home using Learning Express you must **first** sign in like any of our other databases: login is cdhraidrs and password is raidrs. Then you will log in using the personal credentials you created. Remember that your initial registration must be done at school before you have access at home.
