The Cretin Derham Hall Band is a very active organization, being both a part of the regular curriculum and being involved in many co-curricular activities. While scheduling can be a challenge, it is possible to participate in Band for all four years and even be in Sports and JROTC. In fact, the Band started with the JROTC and marched with them as far back as 1918. It's sure to be a valuable experience both musically and socially.

Musically, Band provides a wide range of experiences, including Concerts, Pep Band, Marching (parades and a Homecoming Field Show), and supporting JROTC and alumni events. There are usually four major concerts a year plus Large Group Contest and the Suburban East Conference (SEC) Music Festival in February. Other performance opportunities include Jazz Band, Solo/Ensemble Contest, and auditioning for All-State and/or various Honor Bands. Students improve as a group through daily rehearsals and sectional work, and individually through private practice and four lessons per trimester. Technique, theory, musicianship, appreciation and performance skills are key elements in the musical process, which carry over to every other aspect of life. Studies show a direct correlation between Band participation and academic success.

Socially, Band provides opportunities for camaraderie and long-lasting friendships. The Band room can be a place to call home during your time at Cretin Derham Hall. In addition to working together day after day, the students also attend many activities together. The biggest, of course, is the Band Trip which takes place every other year. The Band has traveled to Nashville, Toronto, Orlando, Los Angeles/San Diego, and St. Louis. This spring we are going to Chicago.
