CDH competes in the Suburban East Athletic Conference.
The conference consists of the following schools: CDH, East Ridge, Forest Lake, Irondale, Mounds View, Roseville, Park, Stillwater, Woodbury, and White Bear Lake. Participation in a large conference ensures games at all levels with top competition and facilities.

Before each athletic season, each sport will hold a parent(s)/guardian(s) and athlete meeting a few weeks before the start of the season.

Attendance at these meetings is strongly encouraged in order to keep up to date on school athletic policies and hear the Head Coaches describe their athletic program. It is also asked that athletic paperwork be turned in at this meeting.

At the ninth-grade level participation is encouraged by offering multiple ninth-grade teams for soccer, volleyball, basketball and baseball. Multiple ninth-grade teams enable most ninth graders to participate, however cuts are made when additional facility scheduling cannot be accommodated, and roster size exceeds normal team size. CDH has several teams that do not cut and encourage participation. Those activities are cross country running, football, alpine ski, wrestling, track and field. CDH's Girls and Boys Tennis have been able to accommodate many new players to the game by offering tenth and ninth grade levels. CDH offers 28 varsity sports with various levels of competition. Getting involved in extracurricular activities have many benefits for students. Individuals involved in sports have the opportunity to meet new friends, learn new skills, stay healthy, and experience team and individual growth.
