#### **APPLICATION DEADLINE: FEBRUARY 1, 2019**

Tuition for each class is \$200.00 and is due following acceptance to the summer session.

#### BEING CHRISTIAN IN THE WORLD June 10 – 14

This course seeks to assist students in developing a deeper social consciousness and compassion grounded in the Gospel and Catholic Social Teaching. This class will be particularly attentive to the needs of those who are on the margins of American society, especially the economically poor. This course will involve hands-on service work with children and families, the homeless, the working poor and those with disabilities. Students will be exposed to and expected to demonstrate knowledge of Catholic Social Teaching. Students will also be required to assist during the month of July with the Project Home homeless shelter program here at CDH, as well as complete several homework assignments that will be due by mid-August.

This summer school course fulfills the trimester 3, grade 11 religion requirement.

Tuition is \$200.00 and is due following acceptance to the summer session.

- Priority will be given to students entering grade 11.
- Independent Study work is also available.
