

### 2017-2018 Cretin-Derham Hall Registration Timeline

January 10	Students will receive practice materials and instructions in homeroom and via their CDH email. Students should verify their user ID and password on Infinite Campus. If a student cannot access Infinite Campus, please seek technical assistance in the Media Center.
January 17	Students in grades 9-11 will report to the theater during homeroom for registration instructions and teachers will explain their courses and department requirements.
January 19	Teachers from a variety of departments will explain their elective courses and department requirements during the noon-time Elective Course Fair.
January 23	Students in grades 10 and 11 will receive their official registration materials in homeroom.
January 23 – February 1	Students in grades 10 and 11 will register online in Infinite Campus. Students must access Infinite Campus through the CDH website and not through the Infinite Campus app.
February 1	Students in grade 9 will receive their official registration materials and register online in their Values class.
March 2	Registration day for incoming 9 <sup>th</sup> grade students. In-person registration will be held for the Summer Health class and the Summer 9 <sup>th</sup> grade Social Studies class at this time.
March 15	Makeup registration for incoming 9 <sup>th</sup> grade students.

### SUMMER SCHOOL REGISTRATION:

January 10	The Summer School Guides for current CDH students and incoming 9 <sup>th</sup> grade students will be posted online and emailed to current students. The applications for the grade 11 Summer religion courses will be available in the Counseling Department.
February 1	Deadline for grade 11 Summer School Religion class applications to be turned in to Ms. Malm in the Main office.
March 2	In-person registration for the incoming 9 <sup>th</sup> grade Summer Health class and Summer Social Studies class will be held during the incoming 9 <sup>th</sup> grade registration.
March 3	Ms. Malm will notify the grade 11 summer school religion students of their acceptance. These students will then meet with Ms. Quitter to adjust their registrations.
