

Interesting Data Set

It's time to find some data that are interesting to *you*! This must be a set of **quantitative** data, which means that the values being recorded are numeric. For example, it could be the number of pets families own, the number of homeruns hit by each team in the league, or maybe the weight of each musical instrument in the marching band. Remember that you will be using this data set several times throughout the year; so make sure it is something that you find value in learning more about.

There must be at least 20 values in your set, and to keep things simple, it's best if there are fewer than 40 values. Give your set an appropriate title and label the units, if needed, to give readers a sense of context for your numbers.
