Rehearsal Etiquette:

Expectations

The rehearsal grade is based on positive participation, attitude and cooperation. As in any other class, disruptive behavior, lack of participation or excessive tardies/absences will affect the grade. Students are expected to have all necessary equipment and music. **Cell phones will not be needed and should not be brought to the rehearsal area.**

Required Gigs:

Students are expected to participate in all required performances such as concerts, parades, field shows and contests - usually 4-5 per trimester.

Lessons:

Four lessons are required each trimester and are graded on a 100-point scale. The fall chair audition counts as a lesson as do chair challenges in December. Forward progress is expected at lessons and poorly prepared lessons may result in the loss of chair position. Students may opt for outside private lessons; the form is in eBackpack.

Pep Band:

Attendance is required at approximately 50% of all scheduled pep band events. **Students are expected to stay in the pep band area, ready to play, until after half-time or until released.**

Other Assignments:

Students may be required to keep legible class notes or handouts on theory, appreciation and terminology. Occasional written tests or assignments may be given.

Honors Credit (4.5)

Open to all 10th, 11th and 12th graders. Grading policies include the above requirements with the following additions. **A student not maintaining General requirements will be dropped from Honors.**

Outside Concert:

Attend a band, orchestra or recital performance (high school level or higher) each trimester. Write a review and turn it in with the concert program (guidelines on the back).

Class Recital Performance:

A solo/ensemble performance each trimester on your instrument.

Lettering Criteria

Grades:

"A" grade for all 3 Trimesters. It is expected that students attend all required events. Scheduling conflicts will be handled on a case-by-case basis. Work is not acceptable for an excused absence.

Contest:

Superior or Excellent rating at Solo/ Ensemble Contest.

Academic Integrity Statement
