Q. What is the Cretin-Derham Hall Legacy Gala Dinner?

A. The Gala Dinner is the premier event at CDH. The dinner draws guests from all segments of the CDH community—alumni, parents, past parents, faculty, our founding religious orders and friends. You do NOT have to be an alumni of Cretin, Derham Hall or CDH to attend.

Q. Will I be asked for a gift at this event?

A. The Gala Dinner is the kickoff to the school's Annual Fund campaign.

Q. How much are the tickets?

A. Each regular admission ticket to the Gala Dinner is \$100. Benefactor opportunities are also available and are explained below. Ticket sales are not intended to supplant gifts to the school's Annual Fund.
