#### Harrana

Our tour of Cuba begins in the island's capital city - Havana. We'll take a guided city tour to take in the Spanish colonial architecture in its 16th-century center. Next - we'll test our culinary skills in a cooking class to learn and taste some delicious Cuban specialties. And no trip to Havana is complete without a dance lesson to experience traditional Cuban dances; salsa, rumba, and cha cha cha. Our first day in Cuba ends with our Welcome Dinner at Casa Alta.

#### Valle de Viñales

Next up is our day trip to the beautiful Viñales Valley which is encircled by mountains and where traditional agricultural techniques are still in use. We'll stop in Soroa (aka "rainbow of Cuba') and Orchid Garden - a gorgeous natural area just southwest of Havana. This region's heavy rainfall promotes the growth of tall trees and orchids. We'll take a tour of the township and lunch at Paraiso Organic Farm.

#### **Trinidad**

We'll depart Havana and travel to a one-of-a-kind, perfectly preserved Spanish colonial settlement of Trinidad. Enroute - we stop in the town of Santa Clara for lunch and a visit to Che Guevara Mausoleum. This afternoon - we arrive in Trinidad which was built on huge sugar fortunes amassed in the adjacent Valle de los Ingenios. Declared a World Heritage Site by UNESCO in 1988, Trinidad's secrets quickly became public property, and it wasn't long before visitors started arriving to sample the beauty of Cuba's oldest and most enchanting 'outdoor museum.' Surrounded by sparkling natural attractions, Trinidad is a short distance from Playa Ancón, the south coast's best beach.

## Cienfuegos

Our next stop is to Cuba's "Pearl of the South" - Cienfuegos. Located on a spectacular natural bay - this UNESCO World Heritage site is a nautical city with an enviable waterside setting. Founded in 1819 - it is one of Cuba's newest settlements, but one of its most architecturally interesting. We'll take a guided walking tour through the city and enjoy the sites and shops in town.

On our final day in Cuba, we'll travel back to Havana and visit the Mercado San Jose - located on the pier of Havana Harbor with a panoramic view of the bay. Local artisans showcase their paintings, historic photographs, embroidered clothing, and handmade jewelry. We'll celebrate our once-in-a-lifetime Cuban trip with a Farewell Dinner in Havana.
