#### BEING CHRISTIAN IN THE WORLD June 11 – 15

This course will involve hands-on service work with children and families, the homeless, the working poor and those with disabilities. Students will be exposed to and expected to demonstrate knowledge of Catholic Social Teaching. Students will also be required to assist during the month of July with the Project Home homeless shelter program here at CDH, as well as complete several homework assignments that will be due by mid-August.

This summer school course fulfills the **trimester 3**, grade 11 religion requirement.

Tuition is \$150.00 and is due following acceptance to the summer session.
