CRETIN-DERHAM HALL REGISTRATION GUIDE

Course offerings are listed by department in the Curriculum Guide. Every attempt is made to schedule students into their first choice. However, everyone may not receive the electives they request. Each student must choose alternate classes during registration in the event of a scheduling conflict, or if classes are full or not offered.

Students will register for the following:

ENGLISH (year long)

Required: *US Lit Comp or US Lit Comp-Honors or AP Language/Comp*

- US Literature/Composition
- US Literature/Composition-Honors
- AP Language/Composition

MATH (year long)

Required: *three years for graduation*

- Course recommended by current math teacher

RELIGION

Required: *Faith & Ethics I, II and one trimester 3 elective*

- Faith & Ethics I
- Faith & Ethics II
- Trimester 3 religion elective

SCIENCE (year long)

Required: *nine credits for graduation*

- Course recommended by current science teacher
- OR**
- three trimester electives

SOCIAL STUDIES REQUIREMENT WITHIN GRADES 11 AND 12 TO INCLUDE:

- Economics or Economics-honors (Grade 11 or 12) **and**
 - AP US Government (2 trimesters in either Grade 11 or 12) **and**
 - 1 Social Studies elective (Grade 11 or 12)
- OR**
- Economics or Economics-honors (Grade 11 or 12) **and**
 - US Government (Grade 12) **and**
 - 2 Social Studies electives (Grade 11 or 12) or AP Psychology

Note: Senior Interdisciplinary Symposium-honors (Spectrum) in grade 12, fulfills **2 required Social Studies credits** in addition to 1 enrichment Social Studies credit.

ELECTIVES

Required: *elective courses to fill 7 class hours each trimester.*

Students who choose to continue in their Math, Science and World Language sequences should register for the courses recommended by their current teacher.

ALTERNATE CLASSES

Required: *Students must register for 2 alternate classes each trimester*
