**Who keeps the money from the raffle sale?**

The co-curricular activity for which the student chooses to sell

**How much do tickets cost?**

\$50.00, payable by cash, check or debit card

**What type of car is it?**

2018 Chevy Cruze

**Who donated the car?**

An anonymous donor

**What are the dates of the raffle?**

**APPROXIMATELY** March 12, 2018 through April 6, 2018

**When and where will the raffle drawing take place?** Saturday, April 14, 2018

at 9:00 p.m. at *Taste of CDH!* located in the CDH Joe Mauer Field House.

Additional raffle tickets will be available for purchase at the door until 8:00 pm.

An admission fee of \$40.00 will be charged to attend the *Taste of CDH!*

**Who can buy a ticket?** Anyone over 18 years of age

**CDH Employees are not eligible to win the car, but family members may win!**

**Do I need to be present to win?** No

**Will the student get more playing time if he sells raffle tickets?** No, selling

tickets will not influence a students' participation in any way.

**If a student is involved in more than one co-curricular activity, can he/she sell**

**for each?** Yes, a student may choose which co-curricular receives which

ticket/money, tickets will be color coded.

**What can the money raised be used for?** Money raised will enhance the budget

of the co-curricular activity and must be approved by the CDH administration. All

money raised must be spent in this fiscal year or the next.

**What should I do with the unsold raffle tickets?** All raffle tickets must be

returned to your co-curricular contact by April 6, 2018—**STUDENTS ARE**

**RESPONSIBLE FOR THE COST OF RAFFLE TICKETS THAT ARE NOT**

**RETURNED!** Each co-curricular activity raffle chair should track the ticket

numbers each student has been given.
