

ACT/SAT Special Testing

Students who are in need of accommodations for ACT/SAT testing should meet with their counselor early to discuss the special testing process. Students with CDH Learning Plans, IEPs and 504s may qualify for extended time and/or other testing accommodations.

Counselors will need to know students' diagnoses, date of initial diagnoses, date of most recent testing (must be within the last 3 years), and will need to discuss what accommodations they are currently using. Counselors may also need copies of testing reports.

There is no late registration for special testing, and it takes time to gather needed paperwork. Students should begin the process with their counselors early to ensure paperwork is ready in time to submit prior to the testing registration deadline.

A student who is interested in the September test date, and will need testing accommodations, needs to contact their counselor in the spring of the previous year. This will allow time to complete the paperwork.

Counselors will work with students to submit applications for special testing, but cannot guarantee ACT/SAT approval
