## Check-In

#### **Introduction**

# **Activity**

These suggested activities can help with creating connections within your CASA family. Some are repeats from past sessions and there are new suggestions as well.

### **Option #1: More Cowbell**

#### Option #2: Enjoy a Snack Together.

It is always nice to share a snack as part of CASA. Continue to create a calendar for snacks for each CASA gathering. Assign certain items to family members. Perhaps plan for a bigger food social around the upcoming holidays. This activity works best when everyone participates and contributes when it is their turn.

# Option #3: Spoon and Puffball Relay [some puff balls in Ms. Tighe's mailbox] You will need: spoons and two puffballs (you can use cotton balls too, or marbles) Goal: To pass a puff ball between team members.

**Instructions**: Each team member gets a spoon and puts it in their mouth. The first in line puts the puff ball on the spoon and proceeds to pass it to the next person, and they pass to the next, etc. The first team to pass their marble through the line gets the WIN.

#### Option #4: Earthquake and Tsunami in Indonesia
